History of the Association

- 2016 Conversations were started related to how to solve the safety problem
 - General Thoughts:
 - Public confidence is necessary for our business
 - Quit complaining about it and fix it
 - Get support of the Fire Districts
- April 2017 formed Non-Profit Corporation
- 2018 began work on a Training Framework
- Late 2019 expect to begin “Certification” Process

LOZ ASSOCIATION OF ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS, INC.

A NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION

PURPOSES

Section 1. The prime purposes of this Association are as follows:

- (a) to organize electrical contractors in the three county area of the Lake of the Ozarks, i.e. Camden, Miller and Morgan Counties. This group shall be formed for self-accountability, training and testing in municipal ordinances, codes and quality workmanship concerning Lake of the Ozarks docks and general electrical work;
- (b) to provide property owners with a tool and a source of information to use when hiring electrical contractors and electricians;
- (c) to provide a means and method for certification of electricians and electrical contractors;



Purpose of the Association

- Vision:
 - Provide property owners competent contractors who can ensure the safety of their docks.
 - Train and develop qualified **ELECTRICAL TECHNICIANS** to work in a Marine environment
 - Understand specific hazards related to docks
 - Understand specific hazards related to boats
 - Understand hazard related to utility systems
 - Understand the purpose of grounding and bonding.
 - Capable of complicated troubleshooting
 - Promote the Association to the extent that only Qualified Technicians can work on boat docks.



What's in it for you?

- An opportunity to be a part of a Community of Electrical Professionals making the Lake a safer place to live and play

 - We will be discussing electrical certification requirement with Ameren similar to the Dock Builders Association.
